RULES AND REGULATIONS

THE *scout* ASSOCIATION

1. Foreword

- 1.1 These rules are drawn up by the Scout Association of Malta Campsite Team, and apply to all persons using Ghajn Tuffieha Camp Site (herein referred to as “the Site”).
- 1.2 The Site is run by volunteers and provided for use primarily by the Scout and Guide Movements. The campsite and facilities may also be used by other youth organizations, institutions, and the general public, subject to approval.
- 1.3 All campers camping at the Site do so at their own risk and the Association is not liable for any loss of property, regardless of how this loss may occur.
- 1.4 Earliest Arrival Time: 14.00 Hrs (or by appointment).
- 1.5 Latest Departure Time: 16.30 Hrs

2. General Rules of the Site

- 2.1 The security gates at the entrance to the site must be **closed** at all times.
- 2.2 Due respect must be shown to the property as well as to other campers using the campsite.
- 2.3 Campers are responsible for the well-being and safety of the children in their care.
- 2.4 Campers are to ensure that they do not create a nuisance through excessive noise (e.g. Music) to other campers on the campsite.
- 2.5 First Aid equipment is the responsibility of each and every camper.
- 2.6 The organisation of unauthorised gatherings/parties is strictly prohibited and legal action will be taken.
- 2.7 Dogs must be kept under control and on a leash at all times and any dogs’ mess must be cleared up.
- 2.8 A general lights-out and quiet time starts at **23.00** hours and lasts till **07.00** hours the following morning. Any person/s not abiding by this rule will be asked to leave the campsite immediately.
- 2.9 Open fires lit on the campsite are to be within a safe distance from any trees, shrubs and tents and should not be higher than 30cm. Fires must be supervised at all times
- 2.10 No fires may be lit adjacent to the rubble walls.
- 2.11 All fires must be extinguished before lights out and campers must ensure that all embers and ashes are extinguished before going to sleep.
- 2.12 The campfire pits must be restored to their original state.
- 2.13 The Campsite Duty Warden must be notified in advance of any visitors – their expected numbers and expected time of arrival.
- 2.14 **Great care of all rubble walls must be taken and at no time can these be dismantled.**

3. Incident/Accident Procedure

- 3.1 Any incidents or accidents are to be reported to the Duty Warden, or if not present, please call **9983 9983**

4. Duty Wardens (when in attendance)

4.1 Users of the site should notify the Duty Warden upon arrival, and before their departure.

5. Vehicles

5.1 The speed limit on the site is **10km** per hour.

5.2 The car park located adjacent to the Main Gate and behind the container is to be used by all campers and visitors.

5.3 **No motor vehicles are allowed to park on individual camping plots. Cars left on the camping plot will incur a charge of Eur 2,50 per day – parking in the car park is free of charge.**

5.4 No unnecessary movement of vehicles should occur on the site between 23.00 and 06.00 hours.

6. Environmental Issues

6.1 No trees should be felled, cut or damaged.

6.2 Rubbish should not be left on individual plots but should be bagged and placed in the skips/recycling bins provided at the entrance to the campsite.

6.3 Materials brought to site for activities should be cleared away at the end of such activity

7. General Ablution Block Rules

7.1 No smoking is allowed in any part of the block.

7.2 The Ablution Block is to be left clean, tidy and secure at all times.

7.3 All windows and doors are to be locked after use.

7.4 The Ablution Block sinks are not to be used to wash cooking utensils - washing of utensils must take place on the camping plot allocated to you. The wet pits created must not be of inconvenience to other campers and the site must be reinstated before your departure.

7.5 Any damage or breakages to any part of the building or its contents may be chargeable.

7.6 Users of the block should be conscious to conserve energy and **switch lights off** please.

7.7 Any incident concerning keys being lost must be reported immediately. A replacement cost for the lock will be charged.

7.8 No naked flames or stoves are to be used within the Ablution Block.

Settlement of Camping Fee	Camping fee is to be settled one day in advance of departure. In the case of late booking, no deposit is paid, but full camping fee must be paid on arrival at the campsite.

- Campers are responsible for cleaning up their campsites and any used buildings prior to leaving.
- Campers are responsible to remove all garbage from their plot on departure and to place it in the skip provided.
